And we have always believed this:

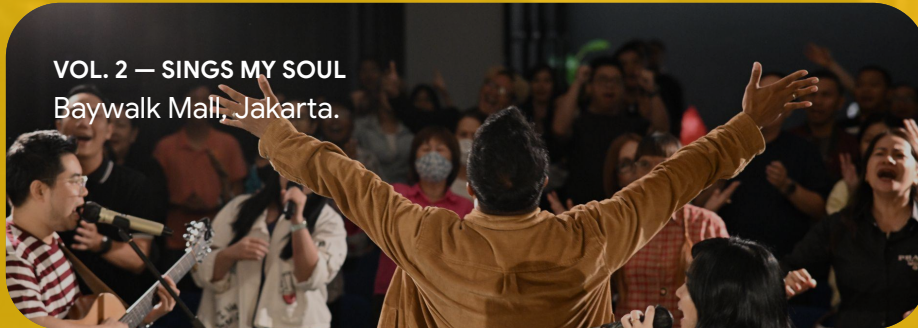
Worship doesn't stay within the room.

This August, we are gathering again to worship.

And once again, our worship moves beyond the room.

In West Jakarta, in a neighborhood called Pekojan,

80 children wake up every day carrying more than any child should.

Their parents are trash collectors, street vendors, and day laborers.
Some children are singing on streets, selling what they can just to help the family survive.

For a long time, learning meant sitting by the railway tracks.
Exposed to the sun, the rain, dirt floors, and the rumble of passing trains.

These children want to learn.
The conditions just didn't allow them.

Then one entity saw the children of Pekojan.



Yayasan Saluran Berkat Mandiri (YSBM)

They are a non-profit with one commitment:

**To break the cycle of poverty by building
an independent generation.**

They moved the children off the tracks.

Into a proper three-story learning house. Safely built for them to grow.

Every week, these 80 children receive:

- Quality education
- Nutritious meals & milk
- Character building & spiritual formation
- Vitamins and healthcare
- School supplies

Aligned with Indonesia Emas 2045, everything YSBM does moves toward three things:
